



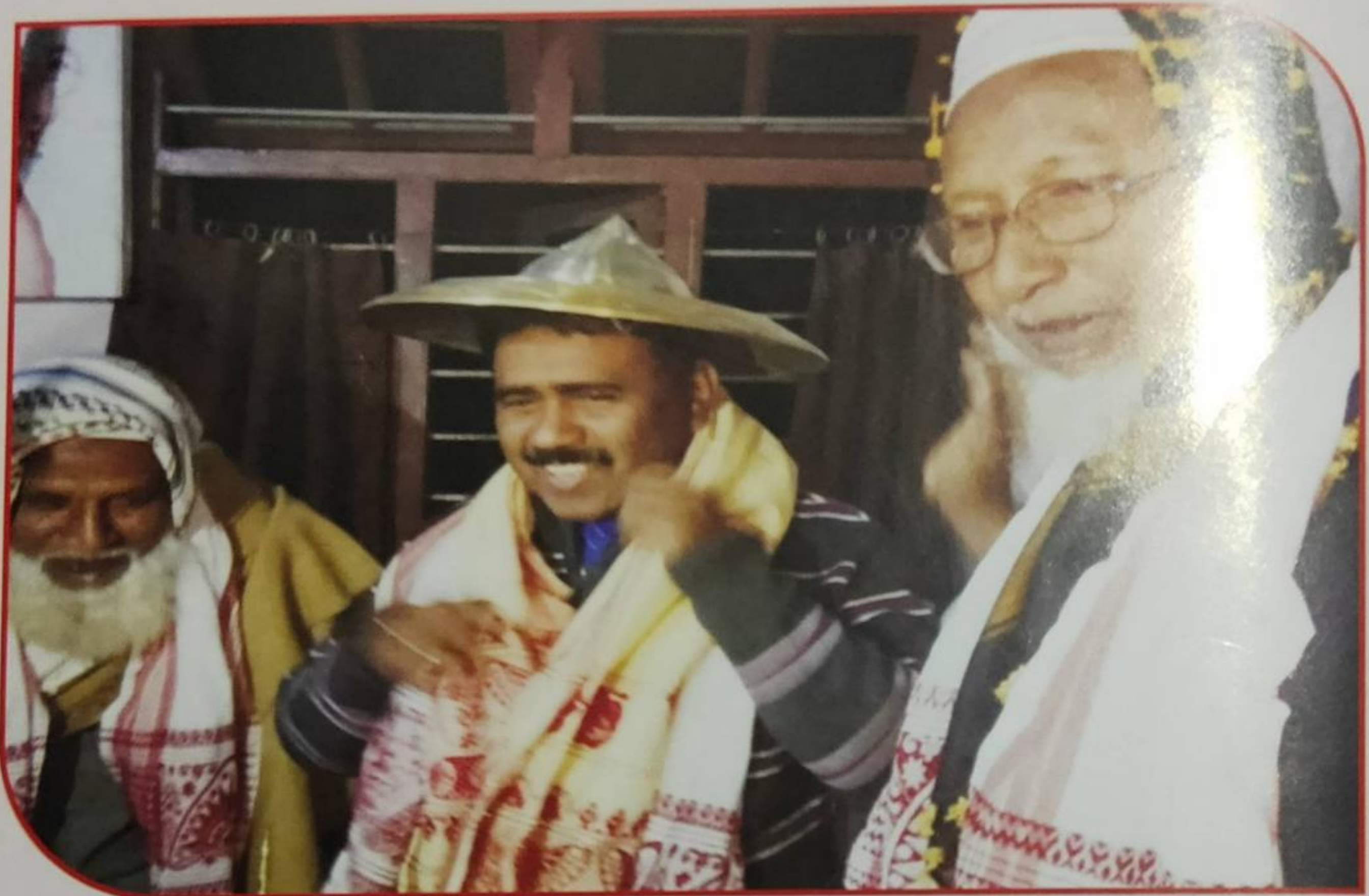

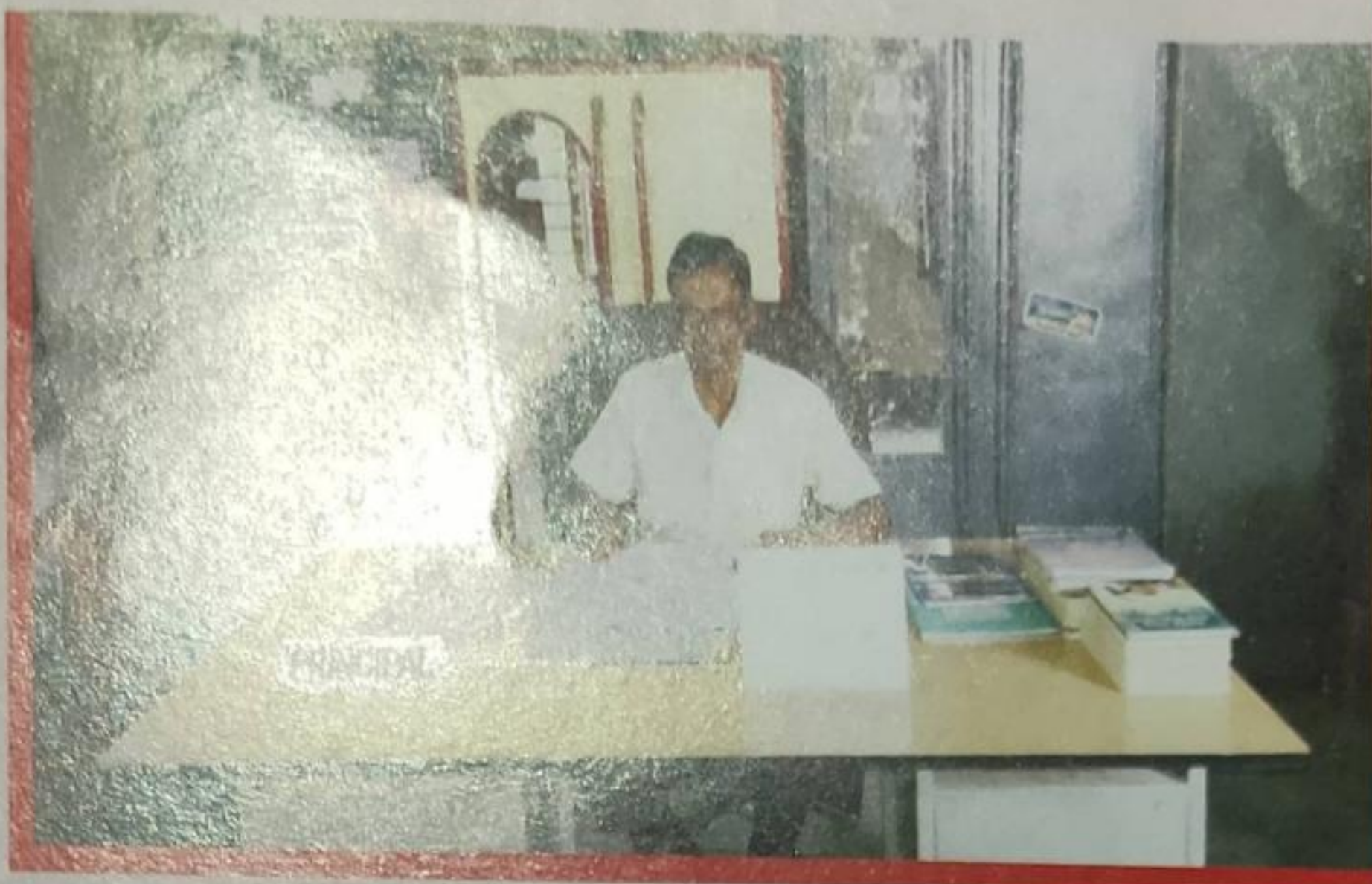

STUDENTS UNION

Barpeta Bongaigaon College students' Union is the only recognized students Union of the college. Each and every students of the college is a member of the union and shall have the right to contest the election to form the Union body.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

For all round development of the learners the college offers facilities of physical exercise through active participation in games and sports and intellectual exercise like participation in seminar, interaction programmes organized from time to time.

RULES AND REGULATION OF THE COLLEGE

- i) Moral values and civil behaviour are honoured above all by the students of the college.
- ii) Utmost importance is given on maintenance of discipline students violating the rules and regulations of the college and indulging in indiscipline are severely dealt and may even confiscate their admission.
- iii) Students must come to the college in uniform.
- iv) Students must keep their Identity cards (issued by the authority) during college hours)
- v) In case of any loss of the identity cards the students will have to report to the authority and procure a duplicate copy on payment of Rs. 100/- (one hundred)
- vi) Any damage of the college property by any student will have to be adequately replaced or compensated for.
- vii) Alcohol, Guthka, Cigarette etc. are strictly prohibited in the college campus.
- viii) In case of absence in classes, students should maintain "Students leave record book, " 75% attendance for every students is must, for less than that a students should pay fine overall attendance at the ends of academic year (period) should be minimum 75%. Any students failing to maintain it will be liable to be discollegiate.
- ix) Mobile phones are strictly prohibited in the college campus.
- x) For all disputes the decision of the college authority is final binding to all.
- xi) The college authority may amend the rules and regulations as and when felt necessary.
- xii) Students must not to be involved in active political activity.
- xiii) Student Union Election will be held according to guideline of University.
- xiv) If any student claim or complain for ragging the remarkable or distinguished student he may turn out from the college.



UNIFORM

In order to maintain uniformity of attire "UNIFORM" has been made mandatory for the students of the college. Details about colour / Shape / size of Shirt / Pent / Salowar / Kamiz / Dopatta etc. Shall notified by the principal of the college at the time of admission.

ATTENDANCE AND CANCELLATION OF STUDENTSHIP

Students must be regular and punctual attending their classes. As per the rules of G.U. students must have atleast 75% attendance in their classes.

In semester system there is no provision of non-collegiate and a student will lost his / her studentship if attendance is below 75%. It is also mentioned that a student failing to attend classes for thirty days at a stretch his / her admission shall be cancelled.

LIBRARY

- i) Students can enjoy the benefit of library services of the college by borrowing books from the college library as per rules.
- ii) The Library remains open from 9 a.m. on all working days.
- iii) To every students of the college library card is issued from the library on the basis of which he / She can borrow books.
- iv) Books borrower will be responsible for any loss or damage of books and have to replace such book by a new one.
- v) Maximum 15 days.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- i) Admission form is to be filled up properly.
 - ii) Copies of all certificates, marksheet, admit and other testimonial will have to be attached with admission form.
 - iii) Students belong to other state board council or university have to submit migration certificate in original at the time of admission.
 - iv) Two recent passport size coloured photographs and one revened size photographs.
 - v) Cast certificate / Other relevant certificates attached with the admission form.
- The date of submission of filled up form and the date of admission will be notified in the Academy notice board at the time of issue of admission forms.



ABOUT IDENTITY CARD :

1) Identity Card will be issue after 15 days of Admission.
